



# Inavale Farm Eventing Derby

Classes offered:

**1) Preliminary**

dressage test 2010 USEF Preliminary test A, jumps max 3'7"

**2) Training**

dressage test 2010 USEF Training test A, jumps max 3'3"

**3) Novice**

dressage test 2010 USEF Novice test A, jumps max 2'11"

**4) Beginner Novice**

dressage test 2010 USEF Beginner Novice test A, jumps max 2'7", one double combination

**5) Intro**

dressage test 2010 USEF Beginner Novice test A, jumps max 2'4", no combinations

**Dressage:** in outdoor arena, sand footing, OR outdoors on grass, depending on weather

**Jumping:** in large cross country field. Courses will include elements of cross country courses and stadium courses appropriate to level, and may include combinations, water, ditches, banks. No bank, water optional at Beginner Novice and lower. Speeds/times will be posted at start.

**Warmup:** dressage warmup in indoor arena, or grass. Jumping warmup in sand arena OR grass field, depending on weather.

**Awards:** prizes to first, ribbons to fifth place, classes may be divided.

**Attire:** boots and approved hard hats with chin strap required, protective vest required for jumping.

**Entries:** Early entry must be received by May 26<sup>th</sup>, \$80. After May 26<sup>th</sup> \$90. After May 26 all fees are non-refundable unless event is cancelled, then full refund. Riders may substitute horses. Checks to Inavale Farm. Visa, MC accepted, call secretary.

**Double entries:** Because this is a schooling event, one horse may compete in two classes with different riders.
